

# U-Haul Equipment Designations

U-Haul equipment numbers takes the form of 2 letters, 4 numbers and one letter. The first 2 letters indicate the model, the 4 numbers are the serial number and the last letter is the suffix which refer, normally, to when it was built or a special characteristics that makes it different from other pieces of equipment of the same type. An example would be a TD-L which has a different coupler type and has a surge brake on it which other TDs do not have.
